



# Yahoo! Go™ for TV Shopping List

Print out this guide to make sure you get the right equipment to fully enjoy Yahoo! Go for TV. Before you head out to the store, make note of which types of video and audio connections your PC and TV accept. Then, take this with you to your local electronics store to get the necessary cables and/or tuner card.

## You will need:

- A Video Cable**  
for connecting your PC's video output to your TV's video input
- An Audio Cable**  
for connecting your PC's audio output to your TV's audio input
- A Supported TV Tuner Card** (optional)  
optional if you want to use the DVR features in Yahoo! Go for TV
- Remote Control** (optional)  
so you can sit back and enjoy!

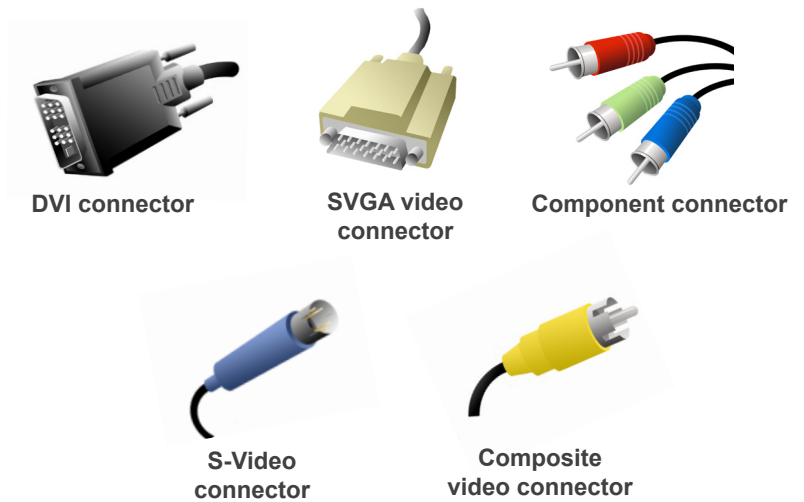

- Stereo phone jack (standard on most PCs)
